

Nurse Education Scholarship Loan Program (NESLP) Application

The Nurse Education Scholarship Loan Program (NESLP) was established in 1989 by the North Carolina Legislature to offer need-based scholarship loans for study in nursing programs offered by community colleges and The University of North Carolina, and by private colleges that offer licensed practical nursing or registered nursing programs. Part-time students (no less than six semester hours per term) and nontraditional students, who have post-secondary degrees, and registered nurses pursuing a baccalaureate degree in nursing, are eligible to receive need-based nursing scholarship loans. NESLP funding is limited and subject to availability. NESLP is a scholarship/loan which means that all funds received through this program must be repaid with service. Failure to repay the loan with service will result in a cash payment in accordance at the interest rate indicated in the promissory note.
